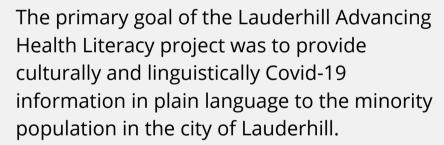
### Background:

The City of Lauderhill was awarded a grant to advance health literacy and enhance equitable community responses to COVID-19. The grant was awarded by the United States Department of Health and Human Services Office of the Assistant Secretary for Health and Office of Minority Health in response to the pandemic's impact on communities like ours.

The grant directly addressed inequities in racial and ethnic minority populations and other socially vulnerable populations, including racial and ethnic minority communities.

The success of this campaign was assessed and measured by residents, local businesses and community partners completing unique surveys produced by campaign partner NOVA University.

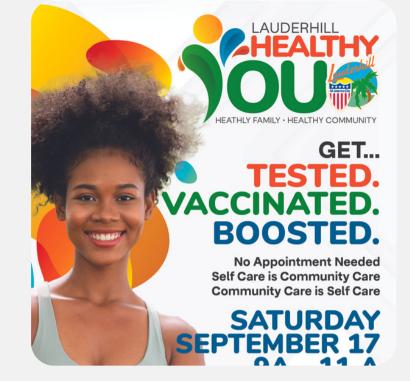

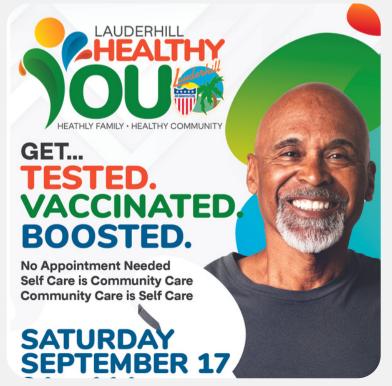
#### **Stratey**

# Community Engagement:

Outcome 1: To what extent have participants improved their health literacy (knowledge) around COVID-19 transmission and vaccination?

Lauderhill Healthy You sought to measure the program's impact on participants' health literacy related to COVID-19 transmission and vaccination.

Through pre- and post-intervention assessments, participants' knowledge levels were evaluated using quizzes, surveys, and interviews. By comparing the results before and after the program, Lauderhill Healthy You assessed the extent to which participants' health literacy improved.

This evaluation provided valuable insights into the program's effectiveness in enhancing participants' knowledge and understanding of COVID-19 transmission and vaccination.

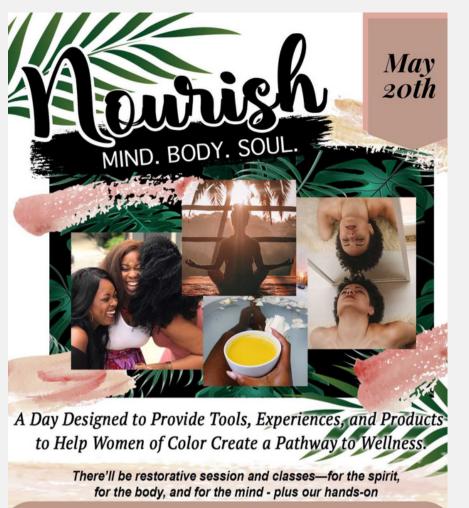
